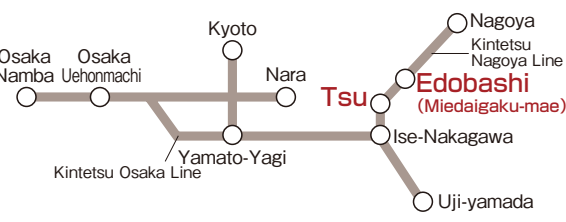
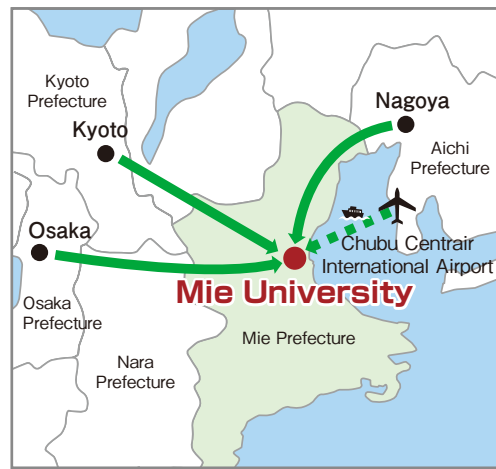


# Mie University Campus Map

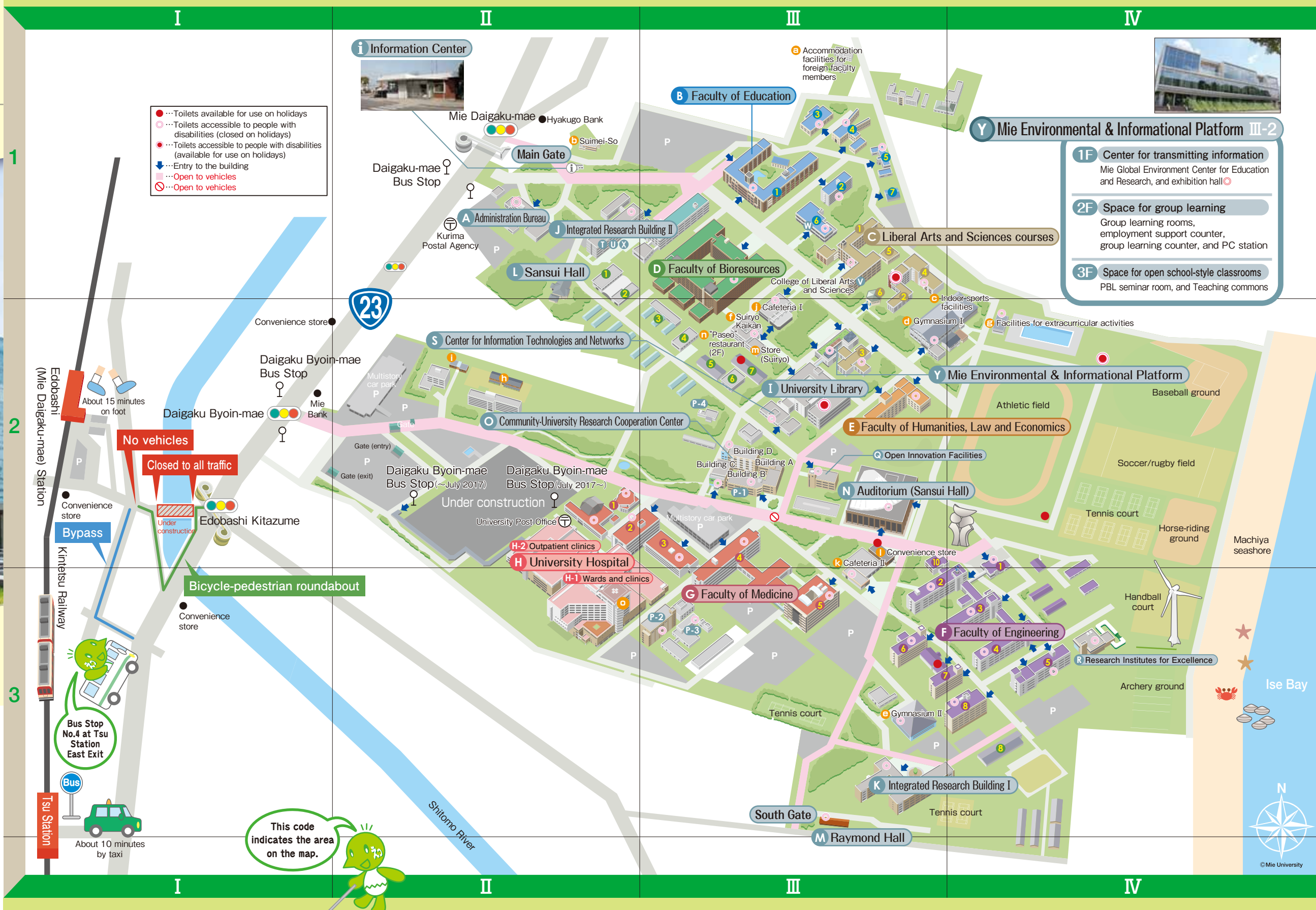
## Access to the University

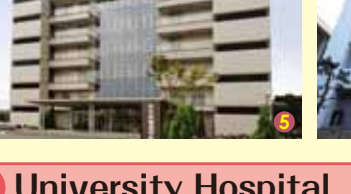

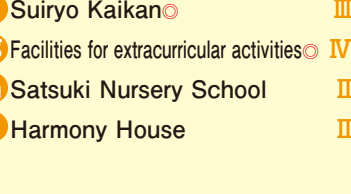
