- 1. It is the area surrounded by a beach facing Ise Bay and the Shitomo River.
- The best evacuation route crossing to Route 23, but...
 To the west: the bridge over the Shitomo River is a high probability to fall down.
 To the north: with a long distance.
- Mie is an area that is susceptible to typhoons every year.

- 1. Mie university sits at 2 meters above sea level in the big sand delta.
- 2. There were lots of rice fields and eel farms around here and doesn't drain well.
- 3. The Nankai Trough Earthquake off the Pacific Ocean will affect quite a widearea with strong tremor and huge tsunami.
