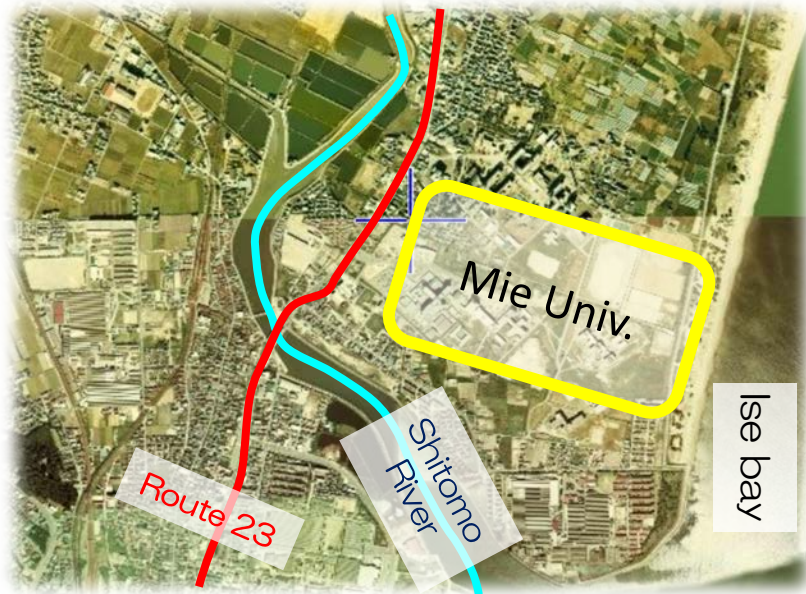


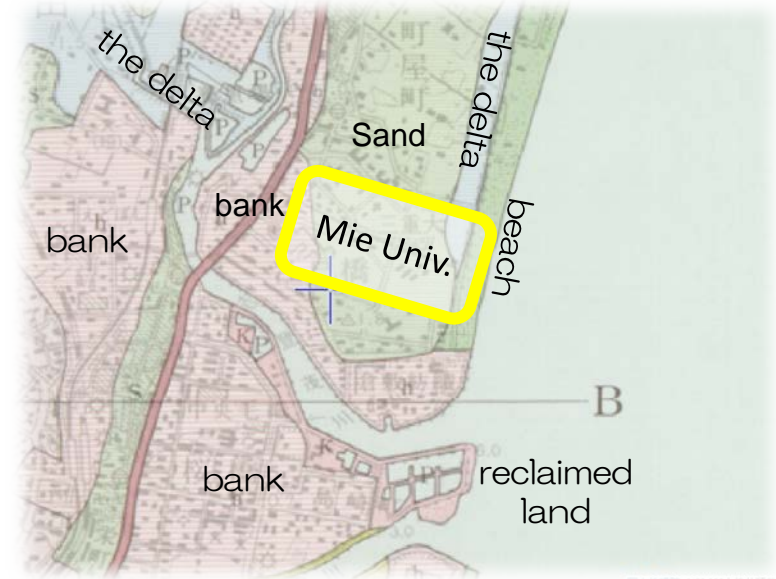
Geographical Conditions around Mie Univ.

See “The Shitomo River, Ise bay and Route 23”



1. It is the area surrounded by a beach facing Ise Bay and the Shitomo River.
2. The best evacuation route crossing to Route 23, but...
To the west : the bridge over the Shitomo River is a high probability to fall down.
To the north : with a long distance.
3. Mie is an area that is susceptible to typhoons every year.

1. Mie university sits at 2 meters above sea level in the big sand delta.
2. There were lots of rice fields and eel farms around here and doesn't drain well.
3. The Nankai Trough Earthquake off the Pacific Ocean will affect quite a widearea with strong tremor and huge tsunami.

This area is vulnerable to typhoons and earthquakes.
