

Mie University Visiting Foreign Research Fellow Hosting Regulations

(Regulations No. 65, May 26, 2004)

Amended March 29, 2007

(Purpose)

Article 1. These Regulations prescribe matters necessary for the hosting at Mie University (hereinafter “the University”) of visiting Foreign Research Fellows engaging in joint research with faculty members of the University, in order to promote international exchange in academic research.

(Hosting criteria)

Article 2. Those eligible to be hosted as Foreign Research Fellows of the University shall fall under the following criteria. However, foreign teaching staff, etc. prescribed under item 4, Article 2 of the Work Rules for Staff Members of Mie University are excluded.

- (1) Recognized as having qualifications equal to or greater than those of a Professor, Associate Professor, Lecturer, Associate Professor (Lecturer), or Assistant Professor of the University
- (2) Able to contribute to joint research conducted in a faculty, etc. of the University for one month or more in principle

(Application)

Article 3. The head of a faculty, etc. seeking to host a Foreign Research Fellow must obtain the approval of said faculty, etc. and then submit the prescribed documents to President at least two weeks prior to the proposed start date of the hosting period in principle to obtain President’s approval.

(Hosting period)

Article 4.

1. The hosting period of Foreign Research Fellows shall be a maximum of two years. However, this period may be extended if necessary.
2. The provisions of the preceding article shall apply mutatis mutandis to the application procedures for any change in the hosting period.

(Duties)

Article 5. Foreign Research Fellows shall engage in joint research in accordance with predetermined research plans.

(Benefits, etc.)

Article 6.

1. No salary shall be paid to Foreign Research Fellows.

2. Foreign Research Fellows may use facilities and equipment of the University as necessary in order to conduct their research, to the extent that such use does not impede the education and research activities of the University.

(Compliance with regulations, etc.)

Article 7. Foreign Research Fellows must comply with the rules and regulations of the University.

(Miscellaneous provisions)

Article 8. Any matter necessary for the hosting of Foreign Research Fellows that are not prescribed in these Regulations shall be provided for by the University separately.

Supplementary provision

These regulations are effective from May 26, 2004, and applied from April 1, 2004.

Supplementary provision (March 29, 2007)

These regulations are effective from April 1, 2007.
