

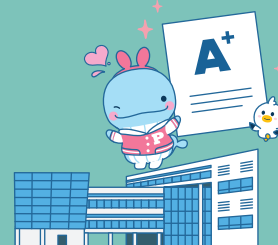

Course Description

Global Culture(Mandatory Course)

PKNU-ISS provides variety of off-campus activities to help students experience Korean culture.

- ✔ Korean Traditional Costume and Etiquette
- ✔ Taekwondo (Korean Martial Arts)
- ✔ K-pop Dance
- ✔ Korean Cooking Class
- ✔ Marine Activities at Gwangalli/Haeundae beach
- ✔ Aquarium visit, Gamcheon Culture Village Tour, Korean Film Museum, etc
- ✔ Traditional culture; pottery making, calligraphy, Korean Rice wine making and more



4 Weeks

Understanding of International Relations (IR)

This course introduces the basic concepts and theories of International Relations. Students will learn about global politics and how countries interact in the international system.

Sports SCUBA diving and Understanding the Aquatic Environment

This course introduces the basic theory and skills of skin diving and scuba diving. Students will learn about the ocean environment through lectures and hands-on diving training.

Sailing Yacht(Water Sports)

This course provides fundamental concepts of sailing, including knots, boats, and yacht parts. It also covers the theory and history of sailing, with lectures in the 1st week and practical training in the following weeks (2nd-3rd week).

Beginning Korean

This beginner-level course is for students with little or no knowledge of Korean. Students will learn basic Korean skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing while exploring Korean culture and everyday life.

2 Weeks

Learn Korean with K-Culture

This beginner-level course is for students with little or no knowledge of Korean.

Students will learn basic Korean skills through K-Culture topics such as K-pop, food, and daily life, with a focus on practical communication.

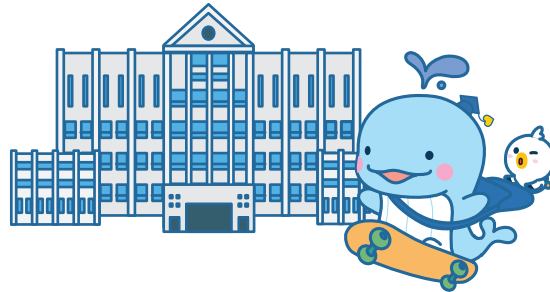

NOTICE

- Must pay during the Payment Period:
 - 4 Weeks : May 11 – 15, 2026
 - 2 Weeks : May 18 – 22, 2026
- Make sure transfer the fee under the participant's name.
- The full payment amount(Program fees) must be received; all remittance charges are the responsibility of the participant.
 - If the full amount is not received, the remaining balance must be paid upon arrival in Korea.
- Payment made after May 10 will not be accepted.
- For any cancellation before the program starts, a full payment will be refunded but a transfer charge will be deducted from your payment.





Visa requirement

It is the participant's own responsibility to check with their country and embassy if visa is required to enter Korea. Participants who need a visa will have to make their own arrangements in applying for the visa prior to their arrival here in Korea. Once we received the payment, we will gladly send you a Letter of Acceptance (LoA).
