



So which attractions should you visit when you are in Hanoi?









The old quarters



Packed with charming colonial architecture, Buddhist temples and pagodas, the Old Quarter, located near Hoan Kiem Lake in Hoan Kiem District, is Hanoi's major commercial district.



Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum in Ba Dinh Square is the final resting place of Ho Chi Minh, the most iconic and popular leader of Vietnam. His body is preserved here in a glass case at the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum in central Hanoi.

Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum

- A beautiful natural wonder in Northern Vietnam near the Chinese border.
- Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1994.
- Located in Quang Ninh Province, about 180km from Hanoi.



- Ninh Binh, a mesmerizing area known locally as 'Ha Long Bay on Land'
- Get a sense of this UNESCO-protected site is by taking a paddleboat tour along its shimmering rivers and climbing to the top of its fabled peaks.

Danang CENTRAL VIETNAM

Da Nang City lies in the Midlands of Viet Nam, from which Ha Noi capital in the North and Ho Chi Minh city in the South are almost equally spaced. Da Nang is also the central point connecting three UNESCO World Heritage sites: Hue Citadel, Hoi An ancient town and My Son Sanctuary.
