(6) Language Requirements

The applicant is expected to be proficient in English or Japanese, and must satisfy ONE of the conditions listed below.

1. Japanese

- (1) The applicant holds grade N2 of JLPT or above at the time of entrance to the regular graduate program.
- (2) The applicant has completed a Japanese-medium school curriculum, which provides a qualification to enter a Master's or doctoral program of Japanese graduate schools.
- (3) The applicant can be considered by the host university as having Japanese language proficiency equivalent to or above 1-(1).

2. English

- (1) The applicant holds an English qualification or English proficiency test score equivalent to or above B2 in Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) at the time of entrance to the regular graduate program.
- (2) The applicant has completed an English-medium school curriculum, which provides a qualification to enter a Master's or doctoral program of Japanese graduate schools.
- (3) The applicant can be considered by the host university as having English language proficiency equivalent to or above 2-(1).
