## Safety and Crisis Management Division (安全•防災•危機管理室)

(Important) For the person who will visit areas where the state of emergency was announced.

(Summary for students)

On April 25<sup>th</sup> the state of emergency was announced in Tokyo, Osaka, Hyogo, and Kyoto, now it will be extended to Aichi and Fukuoka.

Basically, all faculty members, students and staffs are required to refrain from visiting those areas. (Tokyo, Osaka, Hyogo, and Kyoto).

If you cannot avoid visiting due to inevitable reasons such as job hunting or taking national examinations, you need to get the special permission for visiting at your department and take all the precautions as follows;

## 1. Attending classes

- (1) You cannot attend the class on the same day when you came back from those areas.
  - (You can attend only online classes or activities where face to face are not required.)
- (2) You cannot attend the face to face Extracurricular Activities for 14days. (The day of your return counts as 0 day.)
- (3) Some experiments, training programs, seminars, graduation research, or research to take degree, are allowed to attend as an exception. (You should ask your department for details.)

(4) Above all, the medical department or other departments where have some other arrangements or rule, please act accordingly.

## 2. Precautions on visiting

Wash hands often with soap and water, wear a mask and avoid 3 Cs (closed spaces, crowds, and close contact) and 5 situations (Social gatherings with drinking alcohol, Long feasts in large groups, Conversation without a mask, Living together in a small limited space, Crowded break rooms/spaces).

Please take all precautions strictly as follows

- (1) Minimize your stay as much as possible.
- (2) If you have any symptoms of illness, cancel the visit.
- (3) Do not dine with others. (No exception even with a few people or within a short time.)
- (4) Come straight home without stopping on the way.
- (5) Keep distance with minimum people within minimum time

## 3. Precautions on attending unavoidable classes

The day of your return counts as 0 day, please take the following precautions in addition to the usual infection spread prevention measures (mask, hand sanitizer), health management (temperature measurement and action record), and "Current Code of Conduct (Summary and Points to Note)" until 14 days have passed.

- (1) Dine alone and take distance from other people.

  (There was a case that you were counted as a contact person, when you didn't take enough distance with others.)
- (2) Do not eat at cafeteria. (To-go service are acceptable)

- (3) Do not dine with others. (No exception even with a few people or within a short time.)
- (4) Go home right after when the classes are over.
- (5) Maintain a social distancing and minimize your meeting within minimum time.
- If you may have been infected with COVID-19 or have come into contact with an infected person, you need to cope with the investigations taken by the Health Center and take an appropriate response and behavior.

We decide whether you can attend classes or not, so please make a contact with your department or administration office. All students who are in bad physical condition, a contact person, or a close contact person, cannot attend any classes.
