1. Position Title and Number of Openings

Associate Professor, Senior Lecturer, or Assistant Professor – 1 position

2. Employment Status

Full-time (Fixed-term appointment until March 31, 2030)

3. Affiliation

Organization for International Education and Research, Mie University

4. Duties

- (1) Planning and management related to international strategy
- (2) Educational guidance for international students affiliated with the Organization for International Education and Research
- (3) Teaching international collaborative learning courses (including classes conducted in English)
- (4) Managing student exchange and short-term study programs with partner institutions (both inbound and outbound)
- (5) Providing academic and personal support for international students
- (6) Promoting international exchange activities, including the expansion of partner institutions and the strengthening of collaboration with overseas organizations, with a particular emphasis on the African region.
- (7) Other duties as assigned by the university

5. Qualifications

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions:

- (1) Possess a Master's degree or higher (including the equivalent degree obtained abroad), and have at least two years of teaching or research experience by the date of appointment (or be recognized as having equivalent qualifications). Enrollment in a doctoral program (doctoral course) may be counted as a part of the research experience.
- (2) Have experience in international exchange activities such as program planning/management, study abroad, overseas residency, or intercultural exchange
- (3) Have demonstrated excellence in education and/or research
- (4) Possess a high-level English proficiency as required by the Organization for International Education and Research

6. Expected Start Date

As soon as possible on or after October 1, 2025
